Installing

Download and run the 'Signature Manager Outlook Edition 3.0' installation file 'setup.exe'. An MSI is available from support by contacting support@exclaimer.com.

Uninstalling

Uninstall can be achieved via the 'setup.exe' or MSI for the currently installed version of 'Signature Manager Outlook Edition 3.0' or via 'Add/Remove Programs' in Windows 2003 and Windows XP or 'Programs and Features' in Windows 2008, Windows 2012, Windows Vista, Windows 7 and Windows 8.

The uninstall process will not lose any of your configuration or settings. However as a backup precaution you may wish to export your configuration.

Export Steps

- 1. Open the Exclaimer Console
- 2. Select the 'Exclaimer' node
- 3. Open the 'Action' menu
- 4. Select 'Export Configuration...'
- 5. Select a location and filename for the export
- 6. Press Save

This will export all your settings including all your templates and licensing data.

Upgrading

Upgrading from Signature Manager 2.0 to Signature Manager Outlook Edition 3.0.0 can be achieved via the 'setup.exe' which will perform an in-place upgrade.

Important:

When upgrading from Signature Manager 2.0 to Signature Manager Outlook Edition 3.0.0 the product will go into trial mode. You will need to obtain a new license for Signature Manager Outlook Edition 3.0.0 from the Exclaimer Sales team.

New Features

- In-place upgrades. No need to uninstall the previous version.
- Copy and import template data from other Exclaimer products.
- New Policy type for Signature Deployment to enable separate servers to generate signatures for individual OUs.
- Ability to remotely deploy the configuration to multiple servers from a single server.
- Ability to stop processing policies if a policy exception is encountered.
- New "Conditional Field" component.
- New "List of fields" component.
- New "Social media strip" component.
- New "QR Code" component.
- New "Personal Block" component.
- New "Address Block" component.

- New "Other User's AD field" component.
- Nested {fields} can inherit the properties of their parent.
- General performance and scalability improvements.

Changes

- Status view has been removed and all operational events are now logged in the 'Exclaimer' Windows event log in 'Application and Services Logs'.
- Email notifications removed. Notifications are now recorded in the Windows event log.
- Image button in the template editor now uses {Custom Image} field.
- Hyperlink button in the template editor now uses {Custom Hyperlink} field.

Fixed Issues

- When deploying an additional user's signature, the wrong mail format policy would be applied.
- When using the LDAP Query editor in Conditions/Exceptions on the Advanced tab the entire LDAP query was not exposed.
- Table components always had their merge cells option disabled.
- Configuration backup fails in certain scenarios.
- Importing and Exporting configuration files did not clear them from the temp folder.
- The folder selected for image and file location when importing multiple templates was not being retained.
- Members of a group were not always correctly identified in a root/child domain environment.

Known Issues

- Unable to determine Share and Security permissions on a DFS namespace share running in Windows Server 2008 mode.
- Security permissions are not applied correctly if the Deployment share is on a DFS namespace on Server 2008 but running in 2000 mode.
